EVENT INFORMATION:

This will be a triple autocross. The first event is hosted by the Lancaster County Corvette Club (LCCC), the second event by the Central Pennsylvania Corvette Club (CPCC), and the third event by the Corvette Club of America (CCA). The events shall be held on Sunday August 10th, 2008 at the Oregon Dairy Grocery Store and Restaurant, 2900 Oregon Pike Lancaster, PA 17601. Due to the low event entrant fee, no trophies will be awarded.

Eligibility: The event is open to all persons holding a valid drivers license. All drivers shall wear either a Snell SA2000 or M2000 or newer helmet and closed toe shoes. All cars will under go a technical inspection to make sure there are no oil, brake fluid or anti-freeze leaks or other plainly visible safety or mechanical issues with a vehicle. **Passengers are allowed in vehicles if they are not participating in the event and are age 16 and older.** Ages 16 to 18 must have a parental consent form signed and at time of participation. Time permitting, fun runs will be held at the end of the day.

Liability Waiver: All participants entering the restricted area (area other than spectator area) must sign the "Release and Waiver of Liability Form." Restricted areas are pit and staging areas. Spectators are not considered participants. Corvettes participating in the event will be classed as per NCCC rules. Other non-Corvette vehicles or corvettes owned by non-NCCC members will compete in an "open" class. NCCC participants should have their NCCC number at time of registration.

Refreshments: Food and drinks will be available for purchase.

Restrooms: Restrooms are available on site.

Directions from Reading or Lancaster, PA: From Reading – take Rt. 222 south to the "To 272 Oregon Pike" Exit, which is just south of the Brownstown Exit. At the stop sign make a right turn onto Rt. 272 North. Go about 300yds. and make a left turn on Creek Road. Immediately make a left turn into the Oregon dairy drive way. From Lancaster – Take Rt.222 north to the "To 272 Oregon Pike" Exit and follow the signs to Rt. 272. At the traffic light, do not go straight ahead, but make a right turn onto Rt. 272 North. Go about 500yds. And make a left turn onto Creek Road. Immediately make a left turn into the Oregon Dairy drive way.

For those of you who have an on board GPS systems or use Map Quest: The Oregon Dairy driveway entrance is a long macadam drive at this address: 1289 Creek Road, Lititz, PA 17543.
