### MAP AND EVENT INFORMATION:

This event is an adult driving school on Jefferson Circuit at Summit Point. The day will be broken into two parts. In the morning students start with a class, then rotate between three one hour sessions at specific locations on the track. They will practice threshold braking, slalom cone work and skid pad for one hour each. During the afternoon, students rotate between track sessions with an instructor, riding with their instructor and specific classes. This is a great primer for the season and if the students passes the course, is eligible for an NCCC high speed license. This is a rain or shine event.

Speeds are limited to 80mph for the student sessions, so convertibles are allowed (no roll bars required). Wear lace up shoes, cotton long pants and long sleeve shirt and helmet Helmets must be SA rated, 2000 or later; no motorcycle helmets! All cars will be "teched" in the morning. It's a good idea to have it inspected by a qualified technician before the event.

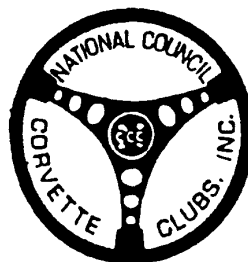
