Regional Membership Director's Report: George Fanucci

We have added two new clubs: Lehigh Valley Corvette Association and the Chester County Corvette Club. With 1774 active members, the East Region is now the largest region in the country, with 31 clubs. There are 3 credits due to the following clubs: ER-354 American Dream Corvette Club- \$20; ER-357 Northern Virginia Corvette Club- \$40; and ER-038 Free State Corvette Club- \$10. These are due to overpayment of active members.

Regional Competition Director's Report: Bud Benton

Bud reviewed the final competition results for 1997. The Awards are ordered and will be given out at the March 21, 1998 Governors meeting by past RCD Bambi Cox. The East Region will also hand out certificates to all winners suitable for framing. Brian Gallagher will handle the printing. We will open this meeting to all NCCC members who may want to attend & congratulate the winners. The awards ceremony will be held prior to the regular meeting, and the guests are then invited to remain or lounge in the dining area. **A REMINDER** As a condition of having our meetings at the Old Country Buffet, everyone is required to purchase a meal, be it breakfast or lunch. Regional Executive's Report: Jeff Port

OLD BUSINESS: A discussion was held regarding our meeting location. This location in Mechanicsburg, PA was easy to find. The location in Harrisburg, PA is a bit more difficult. We already have a motion passed to hold the remaining 5 meetings in Harrisburg. The majority of the people attending this meeting agreed that Mechanicsburg would do just fine if it is available. It is a little closer to the southern clubs. Bill Trethaway will look into this. A motion was made, seconded, and approved to move here if possible. Watch your postcards for the decision.

The region is considering a hospitality space at Corvettes at Carlisle for 1998. John Starry, Governor CCNEPA offered his tent to use.

NEW BUSINESS:

ADD:

Corvette Dream & Drive: There will be two dream & drives in 1998. The first will be in June in the DC area; and the second in July near Phila. The two clubs who participated in 1997's events will be the first clubs offered a chance to go in 1998. They are Allentown Area Corvette Club and Central Pa Corvette Club. The hosts require about 10 people per day for all 3 days, Friday, Saturday, & Sunday Jeff will try to let us know as much in advance as possible as it is somewhat difficult to arrange schedules on a short notice.

The East Region should be working towards a weekend spectacular. We will need to address our financial situation very soon, and such an event can be very beneficial to everyone. It would give people a chance to make new friends, we could hold an official awards ceremony, and the Region could make up some funds deficit. The balance in our Ginnie Mae of \$4,474 will not carry us for 2 more years. A discussion was held regarding other ways to improve our cash flow. They were as follows:

1. Standardize trophies. Buy in bulk around 1500 trophies, and add \$1 to each trophy to the clubs. There

is \$1500 easy money. (Bob Lesh TCV)

- 2. Do away with the awards jackets and shirts. Our events are in the summer and nobody wears them anyway.
 - 3. Charge \$1.00 per entrant versus the current 50 cents. (CCASSN)
 - 4. Hold a 50/50 raffle- possible at CCNEPA's weekend events.
 - 5. Hold a 100 ticket drawing at \$20 per ticket. Give back \$1000 and keep \$1000. (CCC)
 - 6. Hold a raffle at Carlisle based on the state lottery.
 - 7 Auction Franklin Mint Models that we may be able to get donated. (CCASSN)

A motion was then made by George Gallant & seconded by Dave Walter to hold an in house raffle. Cost per ticket will be \$5.00. There will be no limit as to the number of tickets printed. Cindy Manire then made a motion for the winner to have a choice of an all expenses paid Ocean City Weekend for 2 plus \$500 in cash spending money; or \$750 cash. Motion was seconded and approved by a show of hands. The drawing will be held at CCNEPA's weekend event in Scranton, PA. July 26, 1998. Jeff will work on the flyers and Karen will have the tickets printed up by the March meeting.

Good of the Order: Bel Air Corvette Club/ Corvette Club of Northeastern PA

The National Kidney Foundation has extended an invitation to us to attend their "Volleyball-athon" on Saturday May 23, 1998 in Baltimore, MD. This is an interactive event where a team is formed of nine members. Should be alot of fun. See George for further info.

Note: that this weekend is in conflict with an event that CCNEPA is holding at the Pocono International Raceway on Monday, May 25, 1998. This may be the last time we can run the entire track at Pocono. Rates are increasing and smaller events will be the norm in the future. Cost is tentatively set at \$125 per person. Instructors will be assigned to each entrant. Should get 5 sessions of 20 minutes each. Will be held rain or shine. Reminder: the mini-convention in Scranton, PA on July 25 and 26, 1998 will host a car show on the main street of town, autocrosses in nearby lots, and a rallye through town. Hotels are being solicited for package rates.

George also brought up an idea that the East Region should consider hosting a National Convention. This is a long term planning situation, requiring about 2 years to do. We would need a lot of commitment from alot of clubs. We also need a high speed track nearby. Further discussion will be held on this.

CCNEPA Governor John Starry reminded us that he has a few spots for Spring Carlisle available. See him if you are interested.

The March meeting site will be noted on the reminder postcards. All Governors will have to inform any guests of this location.

With no further business to be brought before the membership, the meeting was adjourned at 1:55pm. The next East Region Meeting will be held **Saturday March 21**, 1998 at 11:00 AM.

A motion was made, seconded, and approved to accept the Minutes from the Jan. 17, 1998 East Region Governors Meeting as printed and mailed to all governors. Brian distributed a current list of all Governors and requested everyone double check their addresses and inform him of any errors.

Treasurer's Report: Karen Sellers

Karen handed out and reviewed the Treasurer's Report in the following two segments:

- 1. Cash Flow Report for the period from 1/1/98 through 3/13/98
- 2. Register Report for the period from 1/1/98 through 3/20/98.

An ending balance of \$1809.19 was noted A motion was made, seconded, and approved to accept the Treasurer's Report as presented

We had \$1,315 in trophy fund income for 1997 and \$2,172 in charges for the 1997 awards. A motion was made, seconded, and approved to *transfer* \$1000 from the GINNIE MAE fund to our checking account to cover this expense. We also incurred \$84 in fees to print up the fund raising raffle tickets for the Ocean City Corvette Weekend. The 50-50 drawing held at the meeting netted \$72 to the Region.

Regional Membership Director's Report: George Fanucci

There are currently 1,859 active members in the Region We should surpass 2,000 by year's end. Please remember to double check all names and addresses upon renewing or submitting members and one club check to NCCC is required.

Regional Competition Director's Report: Bud Benton

Bud said that the \$14.40 currently required for postage on event flyers is adequate. He is able to get 3 flyers in for 32 cents Governors should watch their deadlines though. It is <u>VERY</u> important you not miss one as the event sanction will not be granted. If you have any photos of an event, he will be able to scan them into the Competition Report.

NON-SANCTIONED EVENTS: If a conflict on a date arises with a sanctioned event & a request for a non-sanctioned event, the date will go to the sanction if they are within 100 miles of each other. Insurance coverage on non-sanctions will be intact if the event is published in your newsletter and waivers are signed. A non-sanctioned event can be bumped out of a date if a request comes in for a sanction, regardless of type, ie: Sanction Rallye can bump Non-Sanction Concours, etc. All non-sanctions are designated with an "N" number

YEAR 2000 RULEBOOK: A discussion was held regarding the changes proposed. One is the elimination of the "M" class motorcycle helmets. The proposed year of helmets is 1995 DOT minimum for all events. Our region does not support this notion and requests Bud to vote not in favor of this. We would like to see the "M" designation be OK for low speed events and date OK back to 1990.

In Concours, there is talk of splitting the "D" class into two with the chrome bumper cars (68-73) being separated; and taking the "E" class and splitting the early (84-90) cars from the later (91-96) The new C-5 cars will be class "H".

WHEEL TO WHEEL RACING: There is a move to organize a program similar to the Porsche Club racing program. Questions that need to be addressed involve safety regulations, classes, and insurance. The question is: Are the Regions interested in such a program? Our region agreed to have Bud vote YES to proceed on investigation of this.

Regional Executive's Report: Jeff Port

OLD BUSINESS:

The Corvette Ride of a Lifetime, similar to the Dream & Drive program, will be different this year. We, the region, have been asked to be greeters instead of drivers. All participants will get a free lunch & tee-shirt. There are 3 events and 2 conflicts: one being the National Convention and the other CCNEPA's Mini Convention. The third is in Yonkers, NY. If anyone is interested in attending, notify Jeff. The region will send a letter that we are NOT interested in general to be greeters only.

MINI-CONVENTION/FUND RAISER: Flyers will be sent to ALL East Region Households. The raffle tickets for the Ocean City Weekend/Cash are printed and were handed out. Hotel accommodations have been made and are about \$140 a suite that will hold 4 people. FSCC has been working very well with CCNEPA on organizing this event. We have 3 Franklin Mint Models to raffle off thanks to CCASSN and Stan Bachmura. The only request from the Mint is we show a sign with their name on it. It was decided to raffle one at the Ocean City event, one at the Mini Convention, and the third at Carlisle. A fourth model would be available for \$40 if we see a good response to sales.

NKF Fund-raiser: The Volleyball-athon is on for May 23, 1998 George Gallant (BACC) has info REGIONAL PATCHES: Still available from Jeff \$4 each or three for \$10

<u>CONVENTION BIDS</u>: Year 2000 and 2002 are open 2001 is already confirmed A discussion was held to have the East Region possible be a host. A high speed track is required, and due to the immense planning required, year 2002 would be minimum. Idea was tabled for further discussion.

NEW BUSINESS:

SPECIAL AWARDS: Carl Smith-PCCC-brought up an idea for the East Region to follow NCCC in their Special Awards Program for service above & beyond duty. We will need a nomination committee, and the recommendation is one Governor from each state. A motion was made, seconded, and approved.

NATIONAL GOVERNORS MEETING: At the April National Governors meeting, it will be discussed where to hold the future National Governors Meetings. Currently, the site is Louisville, KY and we have a 3 year contract there. That reduces our costs. A proposal is being looked at to move the location around the country, to share in the hosting and offer some who cannot make the trip to KY a chance to attend a national meeting. This move won't happen until at least 2000. An investigation will also be made into whether the Nov 1997 National Governors Meeting followed the standing by-laws. Every Governor should have received a Vision 2000 questionnaire. This is a very good way to convey your clubs interests to National.

<u>FCOA</u>: The Future Corvette Owners of America sometimes gets forgotten. Enclosed with these minutes you will find an application you may photocopy for your use.

NCM: The National Corvette Museum will hold its 5th anniversary this Labor Day. All regions converge at Louisville, KY and caravan to the Museum. A Museum representative may attend our next governors meeting in June to explain and answer questions.

GOLD CLUB AWARD: A reminder that any clubs selling one ticket for each member in their club will receive this award from the National Kidney Foundation To qualify, you need to remit ONE club check in that amount, and the discount tickets do not qualify.

REGIONAL MEMBERSHIP DIRECTOR'S REPORT: George Fanucci. Currently we have 1991 active members in the East Region. The breakdown is 1,394 male; 597 female; 528 spouse; and 23 lifetime members. With applications received today, we will go over the 2000 mark, with Corvette Club of America adding the excess. Any address changes are to be sent to George ASAP so our list is correct.

REGIONAL COMPETITION DIRECTOR'S REPORT: Bud Benton. A new format was added to the competition calendars. Any feedback will be welcome. Bud would like all Governors to try to get the results of their events in a little earlier. Most are making the deadline, however, a few extra days would be appreciated. Please note that on Speed Events, an FTD entrant gets 9 bonus points in lieu of the 7 or 9 class points. Some people are giving 7 points for a first place finish plus 2 bonus points. This is wrong. When sending in flyers, please include a check for \$14.40 payable to Bud for postage. If you have envelopes, you may include them. And if you can fold the flyers, that would be helpful also. His features always has a wealth of info for the lay person. Also, the regional pages have all the info on one page, which makes it better to find events, etc. This whole format change is saving NCCC about \$3000 per issue, thanks to Loretta Spinrad.

Bank ONE Rebates: We are starting to see some rebate money coming in from this credit card promotion NKF Raffle: Sales are moving slow. Any stubs you may have should be submitted ASAP.

K&K Insurance: If an incident occurs at one of your events, send in a report no matter how small you feel it is. Better to be safe than sorry

SEPT National Governor's Meeting: Will be held at held at the Corvette Museum on Sat Sept 12, 1998. The RE; RMD; RCD meetings will be held at the hotel Friday nite. There are no plans for an organized tour of the factory like last year. You will have to make plans on your own for this.

Director of Sponsorship: Pres. Deb Murphy has created this position to stay in touch with all the sponsors of NCCC and solicit new ones. One question arises: What is a Business Manager's responsibilities? Seems like the difference is a 2 year term versus a permanent position.

CONVENTION: We need a messenger for our proxies. George and Jeff are both unable to attend the July event. Dave & Sally Walter can cover for RCD & RMD respectively. We still need an RE rep.

Standing Rules: Will have some changes after the Sept. meeting A vote will be taken in 1999 regarding meeting sites, proxy governors, etc.

OLD BUSINESS: East Region Raffle ticket sales are slow. As of 6/20, we have sold \$1,595. We need to push these for the Mini Convention, being held July 25 and 26, 1998. Rooms will become less available due to the NASCAR race that same weekend.

Franklin Mint Cars: WE have the three models to raffle off thanks to Stan Bachmura and CCA One will go at the convention, the second at Carlisle, and the third at the Ocean City weekend

National Convention Bids: Year 2000 is still open, the 1999 convention will be in Denver, CO.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Jeff Port for Karen Port. Jeff stated our ending balance for the period is \$2,579.39. A motion was made, seconded, and approved to accept the treasurer's report as presented. All in favor.
