Carl reminded everyone that CCNEPA has the East Sectional on May 27-29 at Ponoco Motor Speedway. This is a big event to keep in mind.

As of November, NCCC has over 12,000 members for 1995 The National Governors meetings will be held in Louisville Kentucky. The September meeting will have a bus trip to the National Corvette meeting, leaving early Friday morning.

Something new this year, you will be able to pay for the National Convention with your credit card, either VISA or MASTERCARD

The first 5 by-laws proposals passed and by-law 6, which was the package deal on the Director of Corporate Affairs, did not pass This year National Council is getting a 10% discount by paying the insurance premium in one lump sum, instead of quarterly The quarterly payments ran around \$11,000 to \$12,000, now if the insurance is paid by the December 1, 1994 for 1995, (and it was), NCCC will be saving around \$4,000 to \$5,000 a year.

The Cadillac Dream and Drive program for 1995 is scheduled for March 29 to April 2 at the Capital Center in Washington DC and April 5 to April 9 at Philadelphia Park in Philadelphia, PA At this time, it has not been determined if NCCC members will be participating in these weekend events for Cadillac.

Jay Gittleman has proposed that the East Region donate \$500.00 per year to NCCC towards the NCCC Scholarship Fund with the stipulation that money will be awarded to an East Region's applicant. It was agreed upon to delay this decision until the January meeting This also will allow time for the Governors to present this idea to their clubs for feedback

Discussion was held concerning the current newsletter. It was agreed at this time to present another publication. At present the newsletter is costing the region approximately \$550 00 to distribute and at the last publication, only \$50.00 in advertising was received. The region can not continue to publish this at a cost to the region of \$500.00 each quarter. Several proposals were presented to help absorb the costs. It was asked that the Governors take this information back to their clubs as there will be further discussion at the January meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned
