





Jeff asked that the club information sheets be turned in to him as soon as possible because he has to forward them to Jay and the National Secretary, so the changes can be incorporated.

Jeff passed out information on Orlando Florida for the upcoming National Convention in 1996 kits.

The gift certificate from "Corvette America", for the club with the largest percentage of new members coming in will be given out at the January meeting.

Regional Competition Director - Jeff Port for Bambi Lyberger

Dave Walter talked about the Maryland Motor Sport Park, near Bel Air Maryland, and asked for petitions to be signed to show support for the park. He asked that the Governors sign and take them back to their clubs to be signed at their perspective club meetings. The petition is strictly to show support and interest in this endeavor. The petition will be given to the Motor Sport Park people to answer any questions about what kind of interest is out there in the park.

Carl asked that all clubs get their proxy votes in so the region can be well represented at the National Governors Meetings if the Governors can't make it.

The Trophy fund for 1994 is still in arrears for \$ 129.50. The following clubs still owe money: CCAssn \$ 3.00, CCC \$ 7.75, CMCC \$ 6.00, CPCC \$ 22.75, CVCC \$ 27.00, FSCC \$ 33.25, HACC \$ 11.75, LCCC \$ 3.75, TCV \$.75, USA-1 \$.50, YCCC \$ 14.00. Please bring your dues to the next meeting.

Carl went over the 1995 Competition Calendar and some dates were added, deleted or changed, so please update your calendars.

Dave Walter from CVCC procured a date for May 6&7 at Pocono Motor Speedway for a drivers school. There will be 15 to 20 cars on the track at the same time, each will have an instructor onboard. Passing will be allowed at designated areas. This is a non-sanctioned event.

Regional Executive - Carl Smith

Carl reminded everyone that CCNEPA has the East Sectional on May 27-29 at Ponoco Motor Speedway. This is a big event to keep in mind.

As of November, NCCC has over 12,000 members for 1995. The National Governors meetings will be held in Louisville Kentucky. The September meeting will have a bus trip to the National Corvette meeting, leaving early Friday morning.

Something new this year, you will be able to pay for the National Convention with your credit card, either VISA or MASTERCARD.

The first 5 by-laws proposals passed and by-law 6, which was the package deal on the Director of Corporate Affairs, did not pass. This year National Council is getting a 10% discount by paying the insurance premium in one lump sum, instead of quarterly. The quarterly payments ran around \$11,000 to \$12,000, now if the insurance is paid by the December 1, 1994 for 1995, (and it was), NCCC will be saving around \$4,000 to \$5,000 a year.

The Cadillac Dream and Drive program for 1995 is scheduled for March 29 to April 2 at the Capital Center in Washington DC and April 5 to April 9 at Philadelphia Park in Philadelphia, PA. At this time, it has not been determined if NCCC members will be participating in these weekend events for Cadillac.

Old Business

Jay Gittleman has proposed that the East Region donate \$500.00 per year to NCCC towards the NCCC Scholarship Fund with the stipulation that money will be awarded to an East Region's applicant. It was agreed upon to delay this decision until the January meeting. This also will allow time for the Governors to present this idea to their clubs for feedback.

Discussion was held concerning the current newsletter. It was agreed at this time to present another publication. At present the newsletter is costing the region approximately \$550.00 to distribute and at the last publication, only \$50.00 in advertising was received. The region can not continue to publish this at a cost to the region of \$500.00 each quarter. Several proposals were presented to help absorb the costs. It was asked that the Governors take this information back to their clubs as there will be further discussion at the January meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
