Regional Executive Report - Bill Trethaway

Bill handed out the New East Region Corvette Club Map It shows the location of all 30 East Region Corvette Clubs by state It also shows the outline of all (five) 5 states that make up the East Region He also handed out a list of clubs by city corresponding to the locations on the map

He handed out an agenda for the NCCC National Convention which is being held on July 12-20, 1997 in Cleveland, Ohio He noted that on Tuesday, July 15, the party theme is Regional Hospitality night Regions are asked to supply their favorite drink and a snack A motion was made, seconded and passed for the East Region Members going to convention to participate in an East Region Hospitality Room

Bill noted that a one page description was sent out the January regional minutes concerning the Corvette Museum Bob Deitsch sent a letter out to all club governors about the issue of financial difficulty at the Museum which he presented at the January Regional Governors Meeting. The National Governors Meeting Minutes from February contained information about the museum status which was presented by the Executive Director of the museum

Bill also delivered 1997 NCCC Raffle Tickets from Patrick Dolan, NCCC Director of Charity, to all governors present. There is an award called the "National Kidney Foundation Gold Medal Award" which will be given to every club that sells one NCCC raffle ticket for each member in their club. The National Kidney Foundation became our national charity for the first time in 1996. \$68,640

A question was raised about the checks from the East Region Newsletter. Jeff Port said he just mailed them out a couple of days ago. Let him know if you don't receive yours

New Business

A clarification was asked for concerning FTD trophies and points when master grouping for pre-84 and 84 and up FTD points are given regardless of master grouping FTD points are awarded by group in accordance with the rulebook. Master grouping only applies for trophies

Greg Gable of YCCC asked about classifying race prepared cars for Concours Bambi noted that per the NCCC rulebook, they must meet race prepared requirements which includes a rollbar and proof of racing (rulebook Section 8 4 2)

George Skalkeas of NVCC reported that his club is considering having their annual "Spooktacular" at Summit Point Raceway instead of Old Dominion Speedway. George asked if any clubs would be interested in splitting the costs with NVCC. The event is scheduled for Oct. 18 &19, 1997. They want to have a highly attended event to cover the cost of the racetrack. Summit Point charges \$3850 a day for the big track and \$2500 a day for the Jefferson circuit.

Dave Walter announced that his club, CVCC, will be holding a driving school at Pocono on May 3&4 He will be mailing registration forms shortly

George Fanucci announced that CCNEPA will be holding a driving school on Memorial Day at Pocono Details will sent out in the next couple of weeks.

Bob Dietsch and Terry Popkin of the Corvette Club of America made a presentation to the East Region concerning the current financial status of the National Corvette Museum. They reported that apparently the National Corvette Museum is \$22 million in debt. They wanted to know if NCCC was aware of the seriousness of the Museum's financial debt. The Corvette Club of America's Board of Directors has determined that their club should take an active role in suggesting and evaluating possible solutions and then formulate a plan that would enable the National Corvette Museum to eliminate a substantial portion of the debt. One of the possible solutions that CCA is considering is to make all members of NCCC also members of the National Corvette Museum. It was noted that the NCCC East Region is a Founding Member of the National Corvette Museum.

The following resolution was made, seconded and passed by the East Region Governors present:

"The NCCC East Region supports the Corvette Club of America in their endeavor to save the National Corvette Museum and to inform the National Council of Corvette Clubs Board of Governors of the National Corvette Museum's current financial situation "

George Fanucci thought that it might be a good idea for each of the East Region officers to mention the National Corvette Museum's financial situation at their respective meetings on Friday night in Louisville, KY This would bring attention to the matter before it is brought forth for discussion on the floor of the National Governors Meeting on Saturday

A question was raised about two people owning a car jointly but living at different addresses with both names listed on the title and registration Wanted to know if this was allowed for Concours or not Bambi will check into this

Dave Walter of CVCC asked if any of the governors would be interested in having name badges made. The cost if \$6.00. Contact Dave you are interested.

The next East Region Governors Meeting will be held at the Sheraton Inn in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania at 11:00 AM on Saturday, April 12, 1997.

THE NATIONAL CORVETTE MUSEUM

The National Corvette Museum is a 68,000 square foot superstructure displaying Corvettes and Corvette memorabilia located across the street from the Corvette Assembly Plant in Bowling Green, Kentucky. The 11-story yellow and red conical structure is one of Kentucky's major tourist attractions and houses 50 models from Corvette's 44-year history. The National Corvette Museum is a non-profit, public foundation incorporated in the state of New Mexico and exempt from federal income taxation. Contributions to the National Corvette Museum are tax deductible, as provided by law. The Grand Opening of the home of the American icon - the Chevrolet Corvette, was held in September 1994.

The \$15 million required to build the National Corvette Museum was raised publicly and privately. The advance fundraising activities brought in \$4 million and the remaining money came from the following two loans: (1) a 1st Mortgage of \$7 million and (2) a County Bond of \$4 million. The loan repayment schedule calls for the following annual payments:

Total Annual Payment = \$645,888 + \$374.000 = \$1.019.888

The National Corvette Museum is owned and operated by the National Corvette Museum Foundation. The Foundation performs its functions with an Executive Committee and a Board of Directors. The National Council of Corvette Clubs has a seat on the Board of Directors. The Executive Committee is responsible for the financial affairs of the Museum. For some unknown reason, the Executive Committee does not share information about the Museum's financial status with the Board of Directors.

On Monday, January 6, 1997, the unveiling of the 1997 C5 Corvette took place simultaneously at the Detroit Auto Show, the Los Angeles Auto Show and the National Corvette Museum An organization known as the "Vette Net" formed on the Internet and learned of the Museum's financial difficulty. The "Vette Net", headed by Jim Van Dorn, raised \$70,000 for the Museum on January 6, 1997 at the C5 introduction in Bowling Green. The "Vette Net" plans to continue its efforts to raise money for the Museum

The National Corvette Museum appears to be in serious financial trouble. It has been reported that there is not enough money coming in to pay for the scheduled loan payments. The Museum lists the following sources of revenue: (1) museum attendance, (2) gift shop sales, (3) memberships, (4) brick sales, (5) corporate sponsorships and (6) fund raising. Wendell K. Strode, the new Executive Director of the Museum, is working on ways to increase revenue from each revenue source

Three members of the Corvette Club of America were at the National Corvette Museum for the unveiling of the C5 Corvette on January 6, 1997 While they were there, they learned of the financial plight of the National Corvette Museum. Upon returning home, they presented the information about the Museum's financial status to the Corvette Club of America's Board of Directors CCA's Board determined that their club should take an active role in suggesting and evaluating possible solutions and then formulate a plan that would enable the National Corvette Museum to eliminate a substantial portion of the debt. Members of the Corvette Club of America attended the East Region Governors Meeting on Saturday, January 18, 1997 and told the East Region Governors what their club was planning to do to aid the Museum. The Corvette Club of America is seeking to enlist the support of the NCCC East Region and the National Council of Corvette Club's Board of Governors in finding a solution to the National Corvette Museum's financial problems.

Regional Executive Report - Bill Trethaway

A discussion took place about the status of NCCC with the Internal Revenue Service concerning filing NCCC tax returns and the penalities that NCCC had to pay NCCC has paid penalities totalling \$16,880 for 1990, 1991, 1992 and 1993. IRS said NCCC was eligible to get \$13,440 back leaving a loss of \$3,440. However, the interest on the \$13,440 at a rate of 6% for the 18 months that IRS has held the money means that NCCC will only be out about \$1,000 when all is said and done. NCCC voted to accept the IRS offer.

Bill presented a comparison of the NCCC National Conventions for the following three years:

★ 1997 Cleveland, Ohio

r 1998 St Louis, Missouri

★ 1999 Denver, Colorado

Bill handed out the results of the 1997 NCCC Newsletter Contest County Corvette Association and Northern Virginia Corvette Club entered from the East Region.

Jeff Port of USA-1 Corvette Club reported that his club is considering holding an East Region Spectacular in the State College, Pennsylvania area to help raise money to support the East Region. They are looking at dates in the Spring of 1998 and are seeking other clubs that would be interested in helping out. Events would include Autocross, Concours and Rallye with a possible tie-in with an East Region Awards Banquet

Bill reminded the governors that the following NCCC National Officers will be elected to serve two-year terms as a result of the 1997 National Election: Vice President of Competition, Secretary, Business Manager and Sergeant-at-Arms. Bill noted that the only candidate for each office was the incumbent who was seeking a second two-year term.

Besides the ballots for National Officers, each governor will also receive ballots for two By-Law Proposals and a ballot for the location of the 1999 NCCC National Convention The first By-Law Proposal is to change the NCCC Fiscal Year to the Calendar Year. The By-Laws Committee recommends a vote "For" this proposal. The second By-Law Proposal concerns a proposed change in the duties of the NCCC Regional Executive Committee The By-Laws Committee recommends a vote "Against" this proposal. The 1999 NCCC National Convention Ballot lists Denver, Colorado hosted by the Rocky Mountain Region as the only candidate

Bill explained the absentee ballot procedure and encouraged the Governors to send in their ballots before the deadline of November 5, 1997.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:00 PM. The next East Region Governors Meeting will be held at the Sheraton Inn in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania at 11:00 AM on Saturday, December 6, 1997.

Regional Executive's Report: Bill Trethaway

Bill held a discussion on NCCC statistics regarding past & present membership. 1998 Regional & National meeting dates were identified as well as the National Officer election results. There will be a national newsletter contest again for 1998, with the top 5 clubs receiving an award. Bill distributed an Order form for 1998 NCCC National Convention sportswear for anyone who wants to order convention clothing by mail. Our NCCC insurance rates will not change for 1998. The 1998 Convention, to be held July 11, 1998 through July 19, 1998 in St. Louis, MO, has rooms set aside at \$65/night. A note to all Governors: the Regional Executive needs 5 proxies from each governor. These proxies need the 1998 governor's name, the 1998 Regional Executive's name, and a club seal or notary seal. Make sure your proxies are complete. To be in good standing, each club must be represented either in person or by proxy at 3 of the 5 national meetings. There is discussion at the National level to do away with proxies and only have those in attendance vote on issues. We, as the East Region, are opposed to this.

The NCCC raffle car for 1998 will be a red 1998 Corvette convertible. The National Kidney Foundation will again award clubs that sell one ticket for each member, a Gold Medal Award. Last year, Perry County Corvette Club attained a 100% award, and the Capital Area Corvette Club received a 500% award- meaning they sold 5 tickets for every club member.

This year's Dream & Drive was a success. The region was paid \$840 to help host the Cadillac event. We had 10 people volunteer from AACC & CPCC, and each were paid \$40 for the day, netting \$440 to the region.

The region is considering a hospitality space at Corvettes at Carlisle for 1998. John Starry, Governor CCNEPA will look into this.

There will be a new editor of BLUE BARS. Look for a picture of the 1998 Corvette Indy Pace car- a Radar Blue convertible with yellow seats & wheels. This color actually looks like purple- so you cannot miss it. List price is \$44,990 + \$2,800 for the Pace Car Option. There will be 1,158 made.

Bill reviewed a list of the 1997 NCCC East Region Accomplishments. We should be proud of what we did for 1997.

The Sheraton Inn here in Harrisburg has raised their rates for 1998. Currently, we get the room for free if we buy a minimum of 20 lunches, which run about \$11.50 with gratuity. We charge \$10.00 per member with the Region picking up the balance. Besides the increase, the Jan & March dates for our meetings are not available. Bill checked on an alternative site; namely the Old Country Buffet in Harrisburg, PA. It is real close to our current location. There would be no room charge, however they also request we purchase a meal. They offer breakfast, lunch, or dinner; and all prices are under \$9.00, so there would be no Regional expense. A motion was made, seconded, and approved to move all six 1998 meetings to this location. 


