### **APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES**

### **APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S REPORT**

- Val Cifuni reported the net worth of the East Region is \$16,353.73. The savings account balance is \$14,191.20. The checking account balance is \$2,162.53. The CD account balance is closed. She did explain there was a typo in the Quarterly report which she will correct. Motion made to accept the Treasurer report with the correction made by Clyde Mooney, second by Carl Smith. - The ER 2021 Budget VS Actual was reviewed. Val reviewed the line items. First supply of Shirts was ordered and received. Motion made to accept the Treasurers Report made by Jeff, second by John. All in favor, no opposed.

### **VP MEMBERSHIP REPORT**

- Steve reported as of 5/14/21, there are 16,944 members. There are 235 Clubs. CVCC has 199 members. East TN is the largest NCCC Corvette Club and has 367 members.
- Events are being scheduled.

- Most clubs have seen a bounce back in membership.
- Steve attended the NCM Bash in April. NCM will continue to put literature in the NCM deliveries. There have been 52 new members since January.
- Make sure your club Treasurer is in sync with you when you are doing membership.

- John Cantelmo asked if it would be OK to promote the ER Convention at Corvettes at Carlisle along with promoting new membership. Steve suggested a few ideas on how this can be done. Possibly a flyer or brochure.

## **DIRECTOR OF SPONSORSHIP/CHARITY REPORT**

Michele reported:

- Seven Scholarships will be given out at the Convention in June
- The St. Jude Tire Raffle will be held in September at the Governor's meeting in St. Louis. Beginning January 2021 to date, members have donated \$6,500.00. Congratulations to a member from Binghamton NY who won the set of tires on May 1<sup>st</sup>. Michele thanked all ER members who have made donations to St. Jude's and participated in the tire raffles.
- NCCC has 20 Sponsors. 16 Sponsors donated money in the amount \$32,700 plus 4 additional sponsors donated \$10,000 in products/services.
- Michele will be manning the NCCC Hospitality Tent this year at Corvettes at Carlisle. ER Volunteers will be needed to assist her to give her a brake. An email will be sent out during the summer asking for help. There will be water and light snacks available. The NCCC Hospitality Tent will be located on the Midway.

## **RCD REPORT**

Brian reported:

- Reviewed his handout "What is NCCC".
- Reviewed the points standings.
- Reviewed the rule book change to reduce the number of sanction events from 7 to 5 events per day. Brian has recommended to vote NO for the rule book change to keep it at 7 sanction events per day.
- Someone from California noticed Northern Virginia CC has regional events scheduled the weekend of Convention. The VP of Comp is saying there is no specific verbiage for regional events in the rulebook. Brian had sent out an email to the VP of Comp asking for an opportunity to "present" at the National meeting, to no avail. Brian mentioned other RCD's don't care about this. There will be a rulebook change. Steve suggested maybe changing the name to something other than Regional Event
- The 2020 + Sting Ray will be in a different class. It will be Class I (i).
- C-7 grand sport for 2022 will be Class MM.

### **2022 CONVENTION**

John reported:

- There was a Chairperson meeting this morning prior to this meeting. Everything is moving along nicely.
- John reported at the St. Louis meeting there were a lot of people enthused about the ER Convention.

- John suggested to the Governor's to promote the Convention with your club members. Try to get them to attend and to help work. Harrah's hotel rate is \$119.99 (tax and resort fees are included in the figure). We will have our own tower and a HUGE room where all the action will be. John said this will be a classy event. If members do not want to spend the week in Atlantic City, they can help work for one or two days. We need a Security person to work the Hotel Security. Two people dropped out for doing the decorations. If your club or members use a good trophy company, please share this info with John. Get a sample of a trophy and try to obtain a quote. We will need about 200 trophies. Our goal is to have 500 attendees.
- Shirts were delivered and are being sold outside at the car show. Money brought in with the sales from this order should pay for the next order. We cannot promote our convention until the Thursday of Convention. Please do not wear the shirts at any National events until after the Cleveland Convention.
- Dave Walter commented that we have a good handle on everything, and we need to make this work.
- John is asking for all clubs to donate a door prize. The goal is to have 500 door prizes. Michele has obtained 400 door prizes so far.

### **OLD BUSINESS:**

- Joe Daley mentioned someone was to look into on line registration and electronic waivers. Andy stated the on-line registration is listed in the "Members Only" section on the NCCC Website and is for registering NCCC members only, not for non-members. It is not clear if there is an electronic waiver. Andy stated to contact the Business Manager.

- Next ER meeting is 9/25/21
