### **APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES**

Michele Cantelmo had distributed the minutes from the September meeting via email to East Region Governors and Officers. Michele asked for any additions/deletions/changes to the meeting minutes. Motion made to accept the September meeting minutes by Joe Daley, second by Don Emmons. All in favor. No opposed.

### **APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S REPORT**

- Val Cifuni reported the net worth of the East Region is \$19,300.93 The savings account balance is \$14,192.03. The checking account balance is \$5,108.90. Motion made to accept the Treasurers Report, all in favor, no opposed.

- The ER 2021 Budget VS Actual was reviewed. Val reviewed the line items. Val mentioned the \$31 stop payment fee for the check that was not cashed from the May meeting will be reimbursed by Holiday Inn.
- Val reviewed the 2022 Budget. Motion made by Clyde Mooney and seconded by Scott Fredericks to approve, all in favor, no one opposed.

## **VP MEMBERSHIP REPORT**

Steve Report:

- There are 16,914 members and 235 Clubs. Numbers should increase in January. We are losing 3 clubs. One from the NE Region, 1 from the West Coast Region, and 1 from the Mid West Region.
- December 15<sup>th</sup> is the due date for renewals. Check should be in hand by December 15<sup>th</sup>.
- There have been 275 new members from the NCM program since January.
- All members will receive a hard copy membership card.
- John Cantelmo is working on a new club in NJ, and Steve is also working on a new club in NJ.

## **DIRECTOR OF SPONSORSHIP/CHARITY REPORT**

Michele reported:

- NCCC has 3 new Sponsors for 2022. Ciocca Corvette (formally Kerbeck), Kim's Gold Dust, and Criswell Chevrolet from Maryland. 11 Sponsors have renewed for 2022. Michele is still working with Dr. ColorChip from Florida and Griots Garage. 7 Sponsor Logos will be printed on the back of the membership card.
- The 2021 Club Charity Activity Report is due by the end of January. The Roger Clancy Award is given out at Convention to a club or individual who has done an outstanding job in supporting charities.
- The November St. Jude Tire Raffle was won by Douglas Lyons from Illinois. We will continue doing the tire raffle in 2022.
- Scholarships for 2022 will increase from \$1000 to \$1500. The Sponsors for the Scholarships can continue to donate \$1000 and NCCC will add \$500 to that amount.
- The On-Line Scholarship application will open 1-1-22, and will close 5-1-22. Michele asked to please share this with club members. The scholarships are open to member's children, grandchildren, nieces and nephews.

## **RE COMMENTS:**

- Andy reported the NCCC Rule Book was over ruled. We will stay with the current book. The problem was the 5 sanctions verses 7 sanctions. As a result, the entire rule book was voted down.

## **RCD REPORT**

Brian was not present. Rocky Alleshouse attended the RCD meeting in St. Louis.

- Rocky handed out Brian's report.
- Rocky reviewed the competition calendar for next year.
  - a. There are two conflicts. CPCC & NVCC. David Rodney and Andrej Balanc discussed and worked out the conflict. Both will hold their events on the date chosen. LCCC & KSCC, Clyde Mooney & Wayne Holmes worked out the conflict. KSCC changed their date.
  - b. Corvette Annapolis listed two events for 2022 on the NCCC 2021 Event Calendar instead of the competition calendar that Jeff Port had set up for all to use. The June 18<sup>th</sup> event will have to be a non-sanction event as this date is the weekend after NCCC Convention. The August 7<sup>th</sup> event has to be changed. Due to club standings CPCC has this date. The old RCD or new RCD will inform Denny White of these conflicts.
- Andy reviewed the 2021 Assessment Report.
- Joe Daley wanted to remind everyone if you are having 7 sanctions in one day, you need to provide an award for each sanction. Andy mentioned "you can put on the flyer, in lieu of awards an optional award of (whatever) will be given".
- Rocky reported there was talk regarding making car show points competitive with auto cross points.

## **RMD REPORT**

Scott reviewed the following:

- Renewals are being processed and checks that have been mail will be deposited. Corvette Annapolis and Living the Dream CC are working on their renewals. Scott reported he cannot get a hold of Elite Stylz CC.

- Classic Corvette Club of Maryland was the first club to process their renewals.

- The success of the Convention will depend on the East Region membership. He would like to see 100 ER members attending.
- He thanked everyone for their support and their hard work.
- Dave reported Competition is going well.
- Wayne mentioned registration opens 2-1-22 and Day Pass registration opens 4-1-22.
- Andy thanked John and Dave for stepping up.
- Steve Johnson asked if there was any info regarding the 2023 Convention. John stated the 2023 Convention will be held by NCCC Officers/Members. Michele reported Dale Samuelson asked Betty Parks to be the Director of the 2023 Convention since there were no bids submitted. Scott Fredericks will Chair the 2023 Car Show and Michele Cantelmo will Chair the 2023 Funkhana.

- a. Convention Clothing: John stated "purchase convention clothing or go naked".
- b. Wayne Holmes asked about NCCC on line registration. It was mentioned the NCCC on line registration is believed to work with only NCCC members.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- a. Regional Car Show and Awards Banquet-There was a lengthy discussion. Andy had asked John to obtain information from the AACA. John reported they want \$3000 to rent the hall. Members would get entrance

tickets to the museum. The museum does not do booking like in the past. It is done through C & J Catering. Menu and prices looked good. The \$3000 is a no go as it has gotten very expensive. There was talk about the Hollywood Casino. Meeting room and food were fine. There was a long walk to the banquet room and a long walk to the bathrooms. There was a discussion about America on Wheels Museum in Allentown. There was no interest in America on Wheels as it is too far for most members to travel to. There was discussion to leave it at Holiday Inn. It was mentioned the food was horrible last year. It was very salty. There was discussion possibly holding the event in Maryland or York. It was mentioned we would need to keep this event centrally located for all. This discussion was tabled for the March meeting.

- c. Dave Walter spoke about the Rallye that CVCC is putting on the next day on 12/5/21.
- d. Mike Woods asked what clubs are doing for members who no longer have their Corvette. There was discussion on how other clubs handle this. Some use the status of Associate Member, Honorary Member, or Enthusiast Member.
- e. In Andy's article in Blue Bars, he asked for suggestions, comments, or opinions on an exit strategy. He feels NCCC should focus on the need to modernization to look for ways to bring in new members, rather than an exit strategy.
- f. Anthony Chilbert stated the Website needs to be changed to an easier format.
- g. It was also mentioned the NCCC Website needs to be updated.
- h. Joe Daley thanked everyone who attended the supported the Ocean City Weekend. He thanked Northern Virginia CC for all their help this year.
