### **APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES**

Michele Cantelmo had distributed the minutes from the September meeting via email to East Region Governors and Officers. Michele asked for any additions/deletions/changes to the meeting minutes. Motion made to accept the September meeting minutes by Clyde Mooney, second by Andy. All in favor. No opposed.

### **APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S REPORT-Val not present-Andy presented the Treasurer Report**

- Andy reported the net worth of the East Region is \$33,757.27. The savings account balance is \$24,388.23. The checking account balance is \$9,369.04.
- The ER 2022 Budget VS Actual was reviewed. Andy reviewed the line items. Motion made to accept the Treasurer's Report by Clyde, second by Andrej, all in favor, no one opposed.

- The ER 2023 Proposed Budget was reviewed. Motion to accept the 2023 Budget made by Don Emmons, second by Andrej. All in favor, no opposed. Motion carried.

### **VP MEMBERSHIP REPORT-Steve on the telephone—Andy gave his report)**

Steve Reported:

- There will be a C7 on the front of the 2023 membership card belonging to a G-Burg member Alvin Brown.
- Make sure spelling of names and email addresses are correct when data entering members.
- There is a discount on car insurance from NCM Insurance.

### **DIRECTOR OF SPONSORSHIP/CHARITY REPORT**

Michele reported:

- The Charity committee received 3 hardship requests which were approved and the checks were mailed out. They were for members from Fort Myers, FL.
- There is one Michelin Tire certificate left with an expiration of 6/30/23. In an effort to receive all club charity forms for 2022, the Charity Committee has decided the clubs that submit their club charity form will be put into a raffle to win the tire certificate. The drawing will be at the February Governor meeting.
- The Charity Committee has decided to add a line to the Roger Clancy information page on the website. The added line is “you can only qualify once every 5 years”.
- So far, we have 10 sponsors for 2023. Invoices totaling \$25,000 have been sent out. We have 4 Product only sponsors totaling \$10,000 in products.
- The Scholarship on line application will open 1-1-23 and will close 5-1-23. Judges for 2023 are Joe Vasta, John Cantelmo & Elaine Heretta.
- High Point Cruisers won the Michelin Tire Certificate at the St. Louis November meeting.

### **RE COMMENTS:**

- Andy spoke about NCCC having more to offer than just insurance. He talked about Family Helping Family, Hardship Program, Scholarship Program and Discounts.
- Andy thanked the following out going Governors: Preston Powers BCCC, Tina Gittleman CCNE PA, Denny White CA, Anthony Chilbert CVCC,
- Andy welcomed the following new Governors: Karen Ambrose BCCC, Joe Lazzaro CCNE PA, Nancy Klein CA, Stoyan Lokar CVCC.
- Andy stated the ER Governors did not do a very good job in voting. Voting is very important. Andy reviewed how to vote. The results for President is Deb Murphy and Treasurer is Kay Clawson.
- Andy reviewed the 2023 National & Regional & Convention blackout dates. Questions came up regarding the 6/17/23 and 6/18/23 Pre-Convention dates. He will need to get clarification regarding these two dates. This is tabled to the March meeting.
- Andy reviewed the 2023 East Region meeting dates.

### **RCD REPORT:**

Andrej presented the following:

- Andrej reported there was discussion regarding the National Awards. National is looking how to break up the awards to include car shows, etc. as the current National Awards system is for auto cross.
- There will be no more gold rings awarded to the first-place women & men. By doing this, it will allow money to be used for the other awards.
- Some information is not needed on the event flyers. Address is not needed. You can list phone number and email address. You can use your own made-up flyer as long as all information that is on the standard NCCC flyer is included on your own made-up flyer.
- National will be inserting in the rule book immediately, electric vehicles are band from all NCCC events. This includes non-sanction events as well. Hybrids are included. Dave Rodney had a question about members

driving their own electric vehicles to club meetings, events, etc. Andy stated he will contact Allen Morris, NCCC Business Manager to get clarification.

- Competition Calendar looks good. On January 1<sup>st</sup>, you can go into the National Competition screen to enter your events.
- 2022 Regional Points were reviewed. Andy suggested for Andrej to check to be sure there are no National points included.
- John Daub, Governor from CCND stated if East Region needs sanctions for the annual car show, we can use theirs. Also, Chip Steinmetz stated the same.

- Craig Kamradt Director of PR, has kits available for your use at events to promote NCCC. When done using the kit, you return it to Craig at no charge.
