### **APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES**

Michele Cantelmo had distributed the minutes from the December meeting via email to East Region Governors and Officers. Michele asked for any additions/deletions/changes to the meeting minutes. Motion made to accept the December meeting minutes by Clyde Mooney, second by Joe Daley. All in favor. No opposed.

### **APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S REPORT**

- Val reported the net worth of the East Region is \$36,288.32. The savings account balance is \$24,388.46. The checking account balance is \$11,889.86.
- The ER 2022 Budget VS Actual was reviewed. Val reviewed the line items.

- ER 2023 Budget VS Actual was reviewed. Figure for ER Car Show & ER Spring Banquet figures are reversed. Will be adjusted in next report. Motion to accept made by Joe Daley, second by Don Emmons. All in favor, no one opposed. Motion carried.
- Val questioned if ER should be doing a tax return. There was discussion. Mike Woods will get an opinion from his contact who may know.

## **RE COMMENTS:**

- Andy welcomed ER new NCM Ambassadors Scott & Maryann Lewandowski.
- The NCCC budgetary reports were emailed to all Governors. Andy reviewed the reports.
- NCCC insurance:
  1. Provided by Legacy Insurance Network and underwritten by K&K. Liability coverage has increased from 5 million to unlimited.
  2. Please only use the waiver forms that are posted on the NCCC website <https://www.corvettesnccc.org/> under insurance. New waiver forms are in the works to increase the number of signature lines. Do not use any waivers without the wording at the top of the page. Each participant and/or worker must sign the waiver in person.  
Signing the waiver for someone other than yourself is not allowed.
  3. Only NCCC members are covered by NCCC insurance. Nothing has changed this has always been the case. No matter what you are doing as a club, ONLY current NCCC members are covered.  
Legacy request event flyers include wording to that affect. Example:  
NCCC Insurance only covers current NCCC members OR Only NCCC members are covered by NCCC Insurance.  
If a non-NCCC person objects, they may join as a MAL enthusiast if they do not fit into your club requirements.  
contact Scott Fredericks for assistance.  
EVs are allowed to attend “non-competition” (events not covered in the NCCC competition rulebook) club events. Drive and dines, club meetings etc. are acceptable.  
EVs are not allowed in non-sanctioned “competition” club events such as; car shows, HPDE, etc.
- Proposed standing rule changes:
  - 1.SR-2023-001 Section- Competition, Sub-section 3.
  2. Current rule - 3. The VP of Competition will present the proposed changes to the Rulebook for the upcoming fiscal year for approval by the Board of Governors at the meeting prior to the last Governors’ meeting of the calendar year. The changes to the Competition Rulebook will be approved or disapproved in whole no later than the last Governors’ Meeting of the Calendar year. If not approved in its entirety, the Rulebook would default to the rules in effect for the current competition year. (November 2011)
  3. New wording - 3. The VP of Competition will present the proposed changes to the Rulebook for the upcoming calendar year for approval by the Board of Governors at the meeting prior to the last Governors’ meeting of the current calendar year. Any proposed Rulebook changes which are related will be grouped together for approval. Additionally, Rulebook changes for the same rule which appear in multiple sections of the Rulebook will be grouped together for approval.
  - 4.New paragraph - 4. Voting will be done by electronic ballot no later than the last Governors’ Meeting of the calendar year.
  - 5.Andy reviewed all the above. All Governors present approved the changes, no one opposed.
- Proposed By-law rule changes. The By-law committee is reviewing three by-law changes.
  - 1.Two of the by-law changes are clarification of the 51% club membership rule.
  - 2.The third by-law change will clarify when motions to amend By-Laws shall first be submitted and too whom.

### **VP MEMBERSHIP REPORT & RMD (Rocky Alleshouse gave Steve/Scott's report)**

Rocky Reported:

- Current NCCC membership is 17,651 and 234 Clubs. ER has 1,908 members and 24 clubs. Street Dreams CC in the Virginia Beach area has returned and was reactivated two weeks ago.
- The largest club in the ER is CVCC with 216 members. Beachcombers CC has 204 members.
- The West Coast region has added 5 clubs since November and approximately 460 members. The West Coast Region has 30 clubs and 2088 members.
- All 2023 membership cards and mailers have been sent out. Many thanks to Alvin Brown for letting us use his car on our 2023 membership cards.
- There have been 73 MAL members added by way of the National Corvette Museum delivery program since November.
- Governor's need to be sure to correctly enter member's information into the database.

- Possible realignment of regions will be for a later discussion at the St. Louis meeting. There are 3 regions with a somewhat small member and club count and a realignment would be more cost effective for NCCC. This was brought up by the NCCC President.
- The NCCC Business Manager reminded everyone that the guidelines for liability coverage for non-NCCC participants at our events has not changed. No NCCC participants are not covered at our events. Clubs are covered and always have been.
- Be sure that clubs maintain the required number of NCCC members. Your club is required to maintain 51%. If under 51% and the club made an insurance claim, the claim would be denied.

## **DIRECTOR OF SPONSORSHIP/CHARITY REPORT**

- The Charity & Sponsorship Committee has begun to clean up the member discount page.
- The winner of the February drawing for the Michelin Tires was Veronica Duys from Florida.
- There will be 2 tricky trays at the Convention in Bowling Green. One is for St. Jude and the other is for the Scholarship/Grant Program. Michele will need assistance to help man the tables as she is Chairing the Funkhana, or you can help with the Funkhana. It can be 1 or 2 hours.
