**APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES**

Michele Cantelmo had distributed the minutes from the September meeting via email to East Region Governors and Officers. Michele asked for any additions/deletions/changes to the meeting minutes. Motion made to accept the September meeting minutes by Clyde Mooney second by Don Emmons, all in favor, no one opposed.

**APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S REPORT**

- Rocky reported the net worth of the East Region is \$34,443.80. The savings account balance is \$24,423.03. The checking account balance is \$10,020.77. Motion to accept the Treasurer's report by Carl Sith and second by Joe Daley. Motion carried.
- ER 2023 Budget VS Actual was reviewed.
- The 2024 Budget was reviewed. There was a discussion regarding taking money from savings to make the budget balance. There were also other minor changes. Carl Smith made a motion to approve the proposed budget. Clyde Mooney second. Motion carried.

### **RE COMMENTS:**

- Andy mentioned as per Allen Morris, NCCC Business Manager said "it is up to each region to vote if they wanted to allow EV's at their events". There was a discussion as EV's are less likely to catch fire than a hybrid. Carl Smith made a motion to allow EV's at all ER events, Second by Joe Daley. Vote was taken, all approved, no one opposed. Don Emmons will work on an EV Standing Rule.
- Andy mentioned you can start to enter your 2024 events.
- Andy mentioned if any officers want additional shirts, Carl can order with the award apparel. You will have to pay for your additional shirt.

### **RCD REPORT:**

John Cantelmo proxied for Andrej at the St. Louis Meeting. John reviewed the following:

- December 15<sup>th</sup> the server will be updated by Walt Jenkins. All results must be in by 12/15/23.
- John reported there was a discussion of a regional trophy that can rotate yearly when won at a Regional event.
- Enthusiast members should be able to earn worker points within a Region.
- All rule book changes were passed.
- Carl reviewed the 2023 ER Awards, color of jackets and thread. John thanked Carl for preparing the 2023 ER Awards Standing Report.
- John reviewed the 2024 event calendar and reported there are no conflicts to work out.
- John mentioned he would appreciate your patience while he is the RCD.

### **RMD REPORT:**

- Scott reported as of 11/10/23 there are 18,839 members and 242 clubs.
- When entering spouse or companion information, be sure to link the primary NCCC# to the spouse. Be sure the spouse is linked to the correct primary.
- Use the complete street name and town addresses. Do not abbreviate.
- Scott deactivated the Sweet Dreams Club.
- Scott will begin to work on the ER MALS.
- When entering any new member, use the member look up prior to entering the member.
- When entering the zip code, try to obtain the 4 digit code after the 5 digit one.
- NCCC will be updating the server. Once the server is back up, there may be some problems.
- There is discussion in NCCC doing away with Wells Fargo and going to Chase Bank.
- Craig Kamradt, NCCC Public Relations Director, has banners, flags, advertising info if clubs need them for their events.
- Scott reported there is discussion regarding dues increase for 2025. Primary would be \$35 (up from \$25), Spouse \$15 (up from \$10) and new members \$45. There will be a vote in February in St. Louis. Last time dues were raised was in 1986. The main reason for the increase is the cost of insurance, Blue Bars, and NCCC meetings in St. Louis.
- Membership cards will be mailed out soon with Clyde Mooney's car on the front.
- Scott thanked all Governors for what they do.
