**APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES**

Michele Cantelmo had distributed the minutes from the March meeting via email to East Region Governors and Officers. Michele asked for any additions/deletions/changes to the meeting minutes. Motion made to accept the March meeting minutes, all in favor, no one opposed.

### **APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S REPORT**

- Michael Woods reported the net worth of the East Region is \$30,568.67. The savings account balance is \$24,430.44. The checking account balance is \$6,138.23. Motion was made to accept the Treasurer's report. Motion carried.
- Michael Woods reviewed the 2024 Budget verses Actual to date.

### **RE COMMENTS:**

- There may be a \$25 assessment for National Sanctions.
- All Governors will have a vote if it comes to having the dues increased.
- Andy sent out a survey attached to his agenda email. He wants to know what the governors and members feelings and thoughts are.
- There is talk in making Blue Bars electronic copy only.
- There was discussion of having 3 St. Louis meetings instead of 4.
- NCCC needs to create a Business Model.

### **VP MEMBERSHIP: Scott Fredericks read Steve Johnson report.**

- There are 17,817 members and 234 clubs as of May 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- There have been 107 primary and spouse members since 11/23/23, from the NCM delivery program.
- Most popular colors are reds, grays, white, black and riptide blue.
- NCCC is considering a couple of regions will not have representation of the RE, RMD, RCD at the St. Louis meeting. According to the bylaws, you need to have a certain number of clubs and a certain number of members within the region. This has nothing to do personally, by rather financially. The vote will be done by the membership committee. This may go into effect in 2025. Club's numbers will stay the same, sanctions stay the same, only the number of people sent to the St. Louis Governors meetings would change.
- Scott mentioned the possible increase of dues. There was discussion but was not brought up for a motion by the NCCC Parliamentarian. The motion can still be brought up and voted on at the September meeting.

### **RCD REPORT:**

John reviewed the following:

- Make sure the event sanction number is correct and "er" is uppercase "ER".
- The Host Club is spelled correctly.
- First and last names match their NCCC registered name.
- ER number must be correct.
- Remarks can be put in.
- Workers start on row 100, must list workers.
- Chair and Co-Chair gets 9 points, not 10.
- Anything in yellow must be corrected.
- Don't feel you are bothering him if you need help. What does bother him, is when he reaches out to help you and he does not get a response.
- The VP of Comp is checking the data base for completion of results. He then contacts John if there are problems that need to be corrected.
- John explained the difference between Regional Events, National Events, and Non Sanction Events.
- Most of the computer glitches have been taken care of.
- John suggested manually enter results for the first event. Make a copy, then use that to for the summary sheet.

- All Governors or members can put in a “Clarification Request Form”. He will present it at the National meeting.

## **RMD REPORT:**

- Scott reported since January to date there have been 109 new ER members. East Region has 2109 members.
- The dues increase was shot down at the RE meeting. The RE’s would like a plan for what the money will be used for.
- There is a possibility combining some regions may occur in the future. This will decrease the number of people going to St. Louis National meeting.
- Spouse info needs to be entered correctly and the complete street and town addresses need to be correct.
- Positions that are up for this year are President, VP Membership, Public Relations and Treasurer. Scott is lead on the Nomination Committee and Veronic Duys and Sandy Arnold are on the committee.
- Scott had sent out to ER Governors a copy of the Benefits and Amenities. Contact him if you need a copy.

## **DIRECTOR OF SPONSORSHIP/CHARITY REPORT**

Michele reported:

- There were 29 Scholarship applicants this year. Twenty-four of those applicants completed the whole scholarship application. East Region had 10 applicants of the 29. Kudos to the Governors for getting the word out. Ten Scholarships were awarded at the Joplin Convention. Three Scholarships were awarded to East Region applicants. One from PCCC, one from USA1 and one from CVCC. Thank you to the 3 judges for all their work, Joe Vata, John Cantelmo, & Elaine Heretta.
- There will be some changes for the Scholarship Program for 2025. They will be announced at the September Governor’s meeting and will be shared at the next ER meeting.
