## **APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES**

Michele Cantelmo had distributed the minutes from the September meeting via email to East Region Governors and Officers. Michele asked for any additions/deletions/changes to the meeting minutes. Motion made to accept the September meeting minutes by Don Emmons, second by Carl Smith, all in favor, no one opposed.

## **APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S REPORT**

- Michael Woods reported the net worth of the East Region is \$31,004.26. The savings account balance is \$24,431.87. The checking account balance is \$6,572.39. Motion was made to accept the Treasurer's Report by Jon Borcik, second by Carl, all in favor.
- The 2024 Budget verses Actual was reviewed.
- The 2025 Proposed Budget was reviewed. Reviewed the Mail Chimp expense line and this year's assessment income.

## **RE COMMENTS:**

- Andy reviewed the election results for ER Secretary and RMD. Michele Cantelmo is Secretary and Scott Fredericks is the RMD.
- Reviewed the election results for National President Deb Murphy, VP Membership Sandy Arnold, Treasurer Linda Fairlamb, Parliamentarian George Duncan, Director of PR Jeff Bruggeman.
- The by law change allowing Director of Charity and/or Sponsorship to be held by one person was approved.
- Reviewed the Standing Rule regarding Patches.
- The \$.25 per participant per sanction assessment is tabled as research is needed.
- Andy reviewed the NCCC Treasurer's Report.
- NCCC is looking into a You Tube to promote NCCC.
- Andy would like to do another survey before the February meeting.
- Andy asked for a volunteer to do a Boot Camp for new Governors. No one volunteered.
- Andy announced a new ER club Elite Life Time Corvette Club. The Governor is Scott Fredericks. There are no club dues. This will allow us to use 14 events for the Regional Weekend in May.

## **RCD REPORT:**

John Reviewed the following:

- Members working at the registration table need to see a current membership card. They also need to copy the correct membership number and name as it appears on the card.
- The correct registration information needs to be shared with the member inputting results.
- When using excel spreadsheet it needs to be freshly downloaded. Do not alter the cells.
- Jim Stimmel will be asked to share his step-by-step instructions for data entering results.
- The RCD meeting in St. Louis ended at 11:00 pm with no breaks.
- Clarification for Funkhana Chairperson's discretion can be open top or closed top.
- It appears the flyers can be made more esthetically pleasing, more to follow.
- When inputting results make sure the number of participants and the number of results matches.
- Every result sheet must have at least 1 worker/chair, or co-chair listed. It can be for points or zero points.
- Before John approves your results, no yellow should be showing. Have someone proof it and validate your results 3 times.
- Record Drag indexes have been updated and will be posted soon.

- 15 Travel Points for Convention will go into the Non-Speed Category.
- There will be an award for the top 5 men and ladies for National workers.
- 2024 Competition Calendar is rapidly coming to an end. All types of events for 2025 are being planned, multiple rallye and funkhana events popping up in many regions.
- VP of Comp and RCDs to assist with Tech at the Wisconsin Dells Convention.
- 3 new records have been set for drags in Texas.
- John is on the Safety Guidelines and Procedures Committee.
- There was a discussion regarding clubs' unused sanctions.
- A NCCC Rulebook Car Re-Classification Committee was established.
- John reviewed the rule changes and clarifications.
- John and Governors present worked out the conflicts to the 2025 East Region Event Calendar.
- The date for the 2025 East Region Spectacular Weekend is Friday May 30, Saturday, May 31 and Sunday June 1. Friday afternoon/evening is registration and hospitality, Saturday is the car show. We need someone or club to step up to do an event on Sunday and or Saturday night. The Governors meeting will start in the afternoon on Saturday. The award banquet will be on Saturday evening. This weekend is a fund raiser for the East Region.
- John thanked Carl Smith for doing the Apparel Awards for the 2024 competition season. Carl reported the main color for shirts will be Tan. Carl handed out a list of recipients and asked Governors to notify him by 1-1-25 with the members choice of color thread etc.
- There was a discussion regarding ER clubs borrowing sanctions from other clubs. It was agreed this can be done. There must be a proxy from that club present. The club will send the RCD the spreadsheet and John will upload it. The club that is borrowing the sanctions will be responsible for the assessment fees.

### **RMD & VP MEMBERSHIP REPORT**

- Scott reported as of this meeting there are 1960 ER members.
- When entering renewals check for duplicate numbers, address is correct, and spouse info is correct.
- Renewals are going slower than usual this year.
- Scott needs checks deposited by 12/15/24.
- Renewals after the 15<sup>th</sup> will be considered a late renewal.
- The database will be closed 12/15/24.
- There are currently 231 clubs. Membership is down by 2000.
- There is a new Region-United Kingdom.
- NCM delivery is slow, 78 members as of September.
- Scott reported he has Prostate Cancer. He has no plans to step down as RMD.

### **DIRECTOR OF SPONSORSHIP/CHARITY REPORT**

Michele reported:

- The Scholarship Overview Page has been updated with a couple of changes. NCCC Scholarships are available for the members, the members' children or the members' grandchildren. The online application will open 1-1-25 and will close 6-15-25. NCCC Scholarships are for undergraduate students.
- There was a hardship request in October. The Charity Committee approved the request, and a check was sent out.
- Congratulations to Scott Cox who won the Michelin Tire Certificate. Thank you to all members who contributed to the St. Jude Raffle.
- The NCCC St. Jude Challenge is well underway.

- The 2025 St. Jude Charity Raffle Form is on the website and was attached to Deb Murphy's 12/1/24 email. All members will have an opportunity to win the larger items that were donated from our Sponsors. There will be 2 items raffled off at each Governor's meeting in St. Louis for 2025. A total of 8 items are listed on the raffle form.
- Thank you to Sandy Arnold who donated a new 7 ft. 1995 Indy Corvette Pace Car Go Cart which will be raffled off in November 2025.
- The 2025 Sponsorship is going well. Invoices totaling \$31,000 will be sent out within the next two weeks. That figure is up \$1,500 from 2024.
