APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES

Michele Cantelmo had distributed the minutes from the December meeting via email to East Region Governors and Officers. Michele asked for any additions/deletions/changes to the meeting minutes. Motion was made to accept the December meeting minutes by Carl Smith, second by Don Emmons, all in favor, no one opposed.

APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S REPORT

- Michael Woods reported the net worth of the East Region is \$30,205.01. The savings account balance is \$24,432.47. The checking account balance is \$5,772.54. Motion was made to accept the Treasurer's Report by Rocky Alleshouse, second by Don Emmons, all in favor, no one opposed.
- The 2025 Budget verses Actual was reviewed. Motion to take the 2025 Budget off the table by Don Emmons and seconded by Rocky Alleshouse. There was a discussion. Change the St Louis Quarterly Governor's Meeting from 5 to 3 rooms, and the cost per room is \$152.85. Motion to approve the budget by Don Emmons and seconded by Proxy Alex Mason. All in favor, no one opposed.

RE COMMENTS:

- NCCC has an International Region.
- Reviewed the Standing Rule regarding Patches.
- The NCCC Budget for 2025 was reviewed.
- Andy reviewed the NCCC Treasurer's Report.
- There is a pending claim for embezzlement.
- Please complete the Survey that was sent out. George Duncan, Parliamentarian, will send the survey to the RE's.
- Andy reviewed the advantages of borrowing sanctions.
- The Regional Rebate for 2024 was \$481.00. This is based on competition.
- NCCC wants to pass the dues increase by September. Not sure what the increase will be.
- ER needs to discuss ways to cut expenses. ER is funded by competition, and more and more clubs are not holding events.

RCD REPORT:

John Reviewed the following:

- When preparing the flyer make sure it has all the necessary info listed. Only NCCC members are covered by NCCC Insurance and must be listed on the flyer.
- The event address is very important to be listed and must be correct so the database can give correct travel points.
- When using excel spreadsheet it needs to be freshly downloaded. Do not alter the cells.
- Jim Stimmel will be asked to share his step-by-step instructions for data entering results.
- John reviewed the Rulebook changes that were previously sent out.
- Report everything on the excel spreadsheet. John will send the link for the excel spreadsheet to all Governors.
- Waivers-send John a copy and you keep the original.
- When inputting results make sure the number of participants, and the number of results matches.
- Every result sheet must have at least 1 worker/chair, or co-chair listed. It can be for points or zero points.
- Before John approves your results, no yellow should be shown. Have someone proof it and validate your results 3 times.
- John has a list of clubs who have stated their sanctions can be borrowed from other clubs. The assessment will be paid by the borrowing club. KSCC will have no sanction events this year. John will notify Mike Woods letting him know what club is borrowing sanctions for the assessment report.
- There is discussion about changing the current alphabet classes to align with the Corvette Generation Numbers.
- Rule Book change pertaining to People's and Participant's Choice car shows will be dropped.
- The date for the 2025 East Region Spectacular Weekend is Friday May 30, Saturday, May 31 and Sunday June 1.

Friday afternoon/evening is registration and hospitality, Saturday is the Governor's meeting, Funkhana, and Award Banquet. Sunday is the Car Show. The award banquet will be on Saturday evening. This weekend is a fund raiser for the East Region.

RMD

- Scott reported as of this meeting there are 2016 ER members.
- As of 2/20/25 there were 16,325 members and 230 Clubs.
- NCCC is getting away from Wells Fargo and going with Chase. Send renewal and new member checks to Scott and he will process.
- Scott revised the Governor's User Guide.
- Scott revised the RMD User Guide.
- The NCCC Membership application has been updated and there are a few changes.
- Membership cards were mailed in late January and early February.
- Always search before adding any member to the database.

A total of 8 items are listed on the raffle form.
