APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES

Michele Cantelmo had distributed the minutes from the March meeting via email to East Region Governors and Officers. Michele asked for any additions/deletions/changes to the meeting minutes. Motion was made to accept the March meeting minutes by Carl Smith, second by Wayne Holmes, all in favor, no one opposed.

APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S REPORT

- Michael Woods reported the net worth of the East Region is \$27,028.40. The savings account balance is \$24,432.88. The checking account balance is \$2,595.52. Motion was made to accept the Treasurer's Report by Don Emmons, second by Scott Cox, all in favor, no one opposed.
- The 2025 Budget verses Actual was reviewed.

RE COMMENTS:

- NCCC has a standing rule on the table for dues increase for 2026. It will be voted on in September. Andy will send out a regional vote which he will use the results at the September meeting in St. Louis. He will report how many no's and how many yes's.
- Regional expenses were discussed and how to bring money in. It was suggested to have ER dues for each member and charge for non NCCC Events. Carl suggested waiting to see what National does and revisit this in September. Michele made a Corvette Lap Quilt for a fund raiser for the East Region. Prices of tickets were discuss. It was asked if raffle tickets can be made available at the NCCC Hospitality Tent at Corvettes at Carlisle. Michele stated she would have to get permission from Deb Murphy. Scott Fredericks will pay for the raffle tickets.
- Andy got in trouble for sending out the membership survey. Andy sent it to the E-Board and was told not to send it out. He sent it to George Duncan and he sent it out to the RE's. He does not know if the RE's sent it out to their clubs. What came back was a moderate dues increase and some cuts, example Blue Bars and charge a sanction fee per person of \$2.00.

RCD REPORT:

John Reviewed the following:

- John sent out the RMD meeting minutes from Rene with additional notes.
- The event address is very important to be listed and must be correct so the database can give correct travel points. Make sure the sanction number, time, and chair info are accurate.
- John must upload all borrowed sanctions.
- The chairperson for the borrowed sanctions must be from the club you are borrowing the sanctions.
- New Governors should be hooked up with an experience Governor.
- Carl mentioned for Concours there should be no need for 2 separate classes for C-3 's.
- When using the excel spreadsheet it needs to be freshly downloaded. Do not alter the cells.

RMD

- Scott reported as of this meeting there are 2065 ER members.
- There are 232 clubs with 16,724 members.
- Scott reported there was a glitch in the database with the plus 4 zip code.
- Scott was appointed chairperson of the NCCC nominating committee for the November election.
- Scott thanked Jon Borcik for attending the May meeting in St. Louis. In the future, he will not assign a proxy if he is unable to attend the meeting in St. Louis.

- Report death of members to Scott.

DIRECTOR OF SPONSORSHIP/CHARITY REPORT

Michele reported:

- The online Scholarship application is open and will close 6-15-25. There are 27 Scholarships applicants with 12 applicants who have completed the whole application. ER has 5 applicants.

- There are 4 raffles left for this year. Two raffles in September and two in November.
- Two new Sponsors were acquired last month. Welcome back Mid America Motorworks & Bloomington Gold Corvettes. Total Sponsor money brought in this year is \$41,270.00.
- Michele will be manning the NCCC Hospitality tent at Corvettes at Carlisle and will be visiting with each Sponsor present. Volunteers are needed to help out.
