APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES

Michele Cantelmo had distributed the minutes from the September 2025 meeting via email to East Region Governors and Officers. Michele asked for any additions/deletions/changes to the meeting minutes. Motion was made to accept the September meeting minutes by Carl Smith, second by Don Emmons, all in favor, no one opposed.

VP OF COMPETITION

- Rene Cardenas gave a report via ZOOM. He thanked all Governors who voted for the new program targeting the younger generation.
- Rene will be doing ZOOM webinars on how to prepare a sanction request, upload sanction flyers and how to enter data results.
- David Rodney asked a question regarding the youth program. He suggested maybe adding a non-speed category. He also expressed his concerns about the 500-point minimum. Rene agreed with having a non-speed category and possibly lowering the threshold. Rene will do a clarification in February.

APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S REPORT

- Michael Woods reported the net worth of the East Region is \$27,665.18. The savings account balance is \$24,434.30. The checking account balance is \$3,230.88. Jon Borcik moved to accept the Treasurer's Report, with Don Emmons providing a second. The motion passed unanimously, with all in favor and no opposition.
- The 2025 Budget verses Actual was reviewed. Assessment report was sent out to all Governors. The assessment is higher this year due to borrowed sanctions. Some assessment funds are still outstanding.

RE COMMENTS:

- Andy asked if there were new ER Governors for 2026. Response was none.

RCD REPORT:

John Reviewed the following:

- John reviewed the calendar of events for 2026. YCCC will change their 5/2/26 event to Regional and GBURG will change their 6/20/26 event to Regional.
- John was asked to be the TECH Chairperson at the Syracuse Convention in June. John is seeking volunteers for assistance. David and Dawson Rodney, and Jon Borcik volunteered to assist John.
- If you are using private property to hold your events, be sure to get permission from the property owner.
- If you plan on "entrance fee is being reduce in lieu of awards" be sure the wording is on the sanction flyer.
- John reviewed the clarification on the Economy Run.
- There must be 24-hour notice to have the Funkhana indoors if the weather is bad.

RMD

- Scott reported he is still waiting for club renewals. As of today ER has roughly 1723 members.
- NDCC is dropping out of NCCC.
- NVCC has an option for their members. They can join NCCC and/or club + NCCC.
- Scott thanked everyone for all their work.
- Rocky was the proxy for Scott in St. Louis. The membership report that was given was not accurate. There will be a more accurate report in February. 12/14/25 is the last day to renew. Kentucky was in the IN Region and will now be in the SE Region. There is a by-law change requesting to take out the word "maintain" a minimum of 12 club members.

DIRECTOR OF SPONSORSHIP/CHARITY REPORT

Michele reported:

Charity

- The online Scholarship Application will open 1/1/26 and will close 5/15/26. Did you know a member, club, or region can donate to the Scholarship Program.
- There will be 4 St. Jude Raffles for 2026 with one item per raffle.
- The St. Jude Challenge is well underway. A club or member can submit a check payable to St. Jude at a National meeting or submissions can also be mailed to Michele. A running total will be kept, and the winner will be determined by the amount donated to St. Jude. Winner will receive an award at the annual Convention.
- Donations in the form of a gift basket are being accepted for the St. Jude and Scholarship tricky trays at the June Convention in Syracuse. Please contact Michele for additional information.
- Congratulations to Lloyce Campbell who won the certificate from CarCapsule, and congratulations to Steve Grabenstetter who won the Corvette Go Cart. Thank you to all members who purchased raffle tickets to support St. Jude.

Sponsorship

- Sponsorship for 2026 is coming along. A more detailed report will be available in February.
- A Sponsorship Committee is being formed with the hope of generating additional money for NCCC.

ER-WEBMASTER REPORT

Jeff reported the renewal hosting for 3 years will be more money.

NATIONAL CORVETTE MUSEUM AMBASSADOR REPORT

- Steve Johnson was not present. Scott Fredericks emailed Steve's report to all Governors.

BY LAW & STANDING RULE

- Don Emmons asked to remove the standing rule change for cash instead of clothing for the regional awards off the table. Don made a motion for the standing rule change and Rocky seconded, all in favor, no one opposed.
- Carl Smith will send out the list to all Governors of clothing/cash awards after the last event of the year. He will note on the list this year's color for the clothing awards. Carl Smith informed the Governors the cash option instead of clothing is as follows:
 1. Heavy Jacket—\$65-\$75
 2. Light Jacket--\$45-\$50
 3. Golf Shirt--\$30

FACEBOOK MONITORS

- John turned down one request, and Scott turned down one request and approved two.

IN MEMORIAM:

- There was a moment of silence for deceased members.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Michele had cast one vote for the 2026-2027 elected officers. RE-Andy Alleshouse, RCD-Jon Borcik, and Treasurer-Mike Woods.
- Michele reported there are 8 hats left for sale. The raffle for the quilt has brought in \$575.00 so far. She collected \$215.00 at the meeting from Governors who sold tickets, which brings the total to \$790.00.

NEW BUSINESS:

- The ER meeting location will remain in Grantville, PA.
- The Holiday Inn does not have space for the 9/26/26 Regional meeting. There was discussion and a motion was made by Carl and seconded by John C. to have the meeting by ZOOM, all approved, no one opposed.

- There was discussion about the ER Weekend being one day or two days, and where it should be held. Michele suggested having it held in Grantville for two days. It is more centrally located and if members want to attend for 1 day or 2 day, it is their choice. Jon B. made a motion to have the weekend at the Holiday Inn in Grantville on May 30 & May 31. Seconded by David Rodney, all in favor, no one opposed. Michele asked for assistance for the Car Show and the Funkhanas.
- There was discussion regarding the banquet. David Rodney suggested finding out what the cost per person would be. BACC will purchase trophies for the car show. Andy mentioned having an open car show and advertise outside. Andy was asked to verify the hotel's renovation timeline so that it could be established if the rear parking lot would be available.
- Mike Woods and Andy presented the 2026 Budget. There was a lengthy discussion. Carl mentioned the awards amount is not high enough. It should be around \$2500. IT hosting should be \$1000. Web hosting charge for USA1, PCCC, PACC, needs to be changed to 4 clubs to include BACC. There will be no subsidizing the meals for the award banquet, and ER will not be paying for the dinners for the first-place winners. The price for the meeting room, IT Director fee, website maintenance and hotel stay per night in St. Louis is going up. Andy reviewed that a club or individual can donate to the ER Scholarship. Motion made to accept the 2026 Budget made by Carl and seconded by Rocky, all in favor, no one opposed.

OTHER BUSINESS:

- Jon Borcik will be sending out the ER Newsletter in December. He will skip January and February.
- Jon reported the dates for the Webinar via ZOOM with Rene Cardenas are: January 22, 2026, February 26, 2026, and March 4, 2026. All at 7:00 p.m.
- Jon handed out the 2024 NCCC Patches.
- Jon reviewed a standing rule change that he submitted to fund the East Region. Jon and the group discussed charging each member \$5.00 or \$2.00, or imposing fees on clubs not using their sanctions. Carl Smith suggested to table this for the March meeting and all Governors think about this and come to the March meeting with suggestions.

Motion made to adjourn the meeting at 12:06 by Don Emmons, seconded by Rocky Alleshouse, all in favor.
