APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES

Michele Cantelmo had distributed the minutes from the March 7th meeting via email to East Region Governors and Officers. Michele asked for any additions/deletions/changes to the meeting minutes. Motion was made to accept the March meeting minutes by Don Emmons, second by Carl Smith, all in favor, no one opposed.

APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S REPORT

- Michael Woods reported the net worth of the East Region is \$31,686.37. The savings account balance is \$24,435.32. The checking account balance is \$7,251.05. Carl Smith moved to accept the Treasurer's Report, with Don Emmons providing a second. The motion passed unanimously, with all in favor and no one opposed.
- The Budget verses Actual was reviewed.
- Mike reported ER is on track for expenses. He thinks we will come out ahead this year.
- Andy asked if all 2025 club assessments were submitted, Mike stated yes.
- Andy mentioned \$400 was submitted from PACC and CC-NEPA (\$200 each) as scholarship donation. He will give checks to Michele to deposit.

RE COMMENTS: Andy reported:

- Andy welcomed new Governor Andrew VanderPoll.
- Andy gave an update as to why he did not like the proposal on the first time Corvette buyers from second tier dealers with a reduced membership fee of \$25 primary and \$10 companion. He abstained from voting.
- At the last meeting Don Emmons had a question about a line item on the National Treasurer's Report under Regional Awards. Andy asked the Treasurer and was explained to him that it is funding for the National Competition Awards.

RCD REPORT: Jon reviewed the following:

- Most point leaders are from FL, MI, EO, and West Regions due to the season starting early.
- Convention- FCOA Competition-no participants. Young Guns-one participants. 8 Participants for the ZORA Competition.
- The Element Fire Extinguisher can be placed in the glove box or console without a bracket. Unanimously approved and becomes effective immediately.
- Fire Extinguishers are now recommended but not required in Groups 1S, 1& 2 at High Speed events. Was approved and is effective immediately.
- Chairpersons and Co-Chairpersons to chair any event they host even if the sanction is borrowed. Approved and will be presented to the Governors for a vote at the September meeting.
- Allowing the Chairperson and Co-Chairpersons to receive points limited to 5 events as Chairperson and 5 events as Co-Chairperson. It was approved and will be presented to the Governors for a vote at the September meeting.
- NCCC members participating at Convention to receive 15 National Points in lieu of the current National Points for each competitive event entered. It was approved and will be presented to the Governors for a vote at the September meeting.
- The RCD's were instructed to review Chapter 9- Protests and Appeals for the September National meeting.
- If you are attending a high speed driving school, obtain a certificate signed by an instructor and email to Jon so he can update your license.
- John Cantelmo is the Chairperson for TECH at Convention. Please contact him if interested in helping out.
- 14 of the 23 East Region Clubs have entered National Sanctioned Events so far this year.
- Reminders: Download the latest Waiver Forms. Download the latest Rule Book Competition Results Spreadsheet. Results must be entered within 15 days. Waivers are to be emailed to Jon. Check out the Governor's Garage for how to enter an event. Click on the Governor's Tools.

RMD-Scott reported:

- East Region has 1797 members.
- Scott thanked Michele for proxying for him in St. Louis.
- Scott welcomed new Governor Andrew VanderPoll.

- Scott announced he will be stepping down as RMD effective 7/1/26. He thanked everyone for making his job easy. Rocky Alleshouse will fill in for him till end of the year. Andy thanked Scott for all his work. Andy announced the appointment of Rocky as RMD until the next election cycle in December. He asked Governors for their approval. All agreed, no objections.

Michele reported:

- As of May 1, NCCC has 14,715 members and 217 clubs. There were 20 MAL members from the NCM Delivery Program since the February meeting.
- Items to use to Promote NCCC-Insurance FAQ's, Discounts, NCCC Bifold Benefits Brochure.
- NCCC will have a Hospitality Tent at Eureka Springs, Bloomington Gold, and Corvettes at Carlisle.
- Suggestions are needed to continue the FCOA Program.
- Amelia Workman printed some membership cards that were not received by members. She will continue to print them as needed.
- There was a discussion on merging regions. Send email to Sandy Arnold with suggestions before the September meeting.
- Michele reviewed how to apply for an NCCC Scholarship and spoke about the new Sponsor Race America.

DIRECTOR OF SPONSORSHIP/CHARITY REPORT-Michele reported:

- Congratulations to Andy Alleshouse who won the \$1,000 gift certificate from Summit Racing. Thank you to all members who purchased raffle tickets to support St. Jude.
- As of 5/15/26 there are 17 Scholarship applicants with 10 who have completed the process.
- The Charity committee approved a Hardship request.
- There will be two tricky trays at Convention. One will support St. Jude and one will support the Scholarship/Hardship Programs.
- New Sponsor Race America will give NCCC members 15% off of new timing equipment and 10% off parts and displays. The discounted savings will be sent to NCCC.
- Once again, volunteers are needed to help man the NCCC Hospitality Tent at Corvettes at Carlisle. Contact Michele with a day and time if you would like to volunteer.

ER-WEBMASTER REPORT-Jeff reported:

Jeff made a few adjustments to Facebook. He added some rules. He will monitor and enforce the posting rules.

NATIONAL CORVETTE MUSEUM AMBASSADOR REPORT

- Steve Johnson was not present. His report was sent to all Governors via email after the meeting.

BY LAW & STANDING RULE

- There was discussion regarding the changes to borrowing sanctions. Two changes were submitted by Don and were reviewed. It was agreed the wording of proposed standing rule 1 – the word “schedule” needs to be used.
- Don was asked to draft proposed changes to the standing rule regarding the minimum number of events required to qualify for regional awards. What is being considered is 10-12 events on multiple days. He was asked to have the proposed change for the September meeting.
- Don was asked to draft an alternative language for regional awards criteria and present it at the September meeting.

FACEBOOK MONITORS

- John removed a flyer that got posted, and Scott turned down one request. John mentioned that the Facebook group page is strictly for ER members only.

IN MEMORIAM: There was a moment of silence for deceased members.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Michele reported there are 6 ER hats left for sale. She will bring them to the ER Weekend in May.
- Michele reported ER is \$25.00 away from the \$1,000 goal of raffle tickets for the Corvette Quilt.
- Michele reported the ER Weekend has 19 cars registered so far for Saturday and 12 cars for Sunday.

NEW BUSINESS:

- There was discussion on what day and time we should have a Zoom meeting for the September Governor's meeting as there is not a meeting room available at the Holiday Inn. September meeting will be held on Thursday 9/24/26 at 7:00.
- Officer nominations need to be submitted by the September meeting and will be voted on at the December meeting. Positions are Secretary, RMD, and RE. Andy appointed Rocky as RMD for the balance of the year. All Governor approved.

OTHER BUSINESS:

- John Cantelmo is TECH Chairman for the Syracuse Convention. He will need help teching cars. If you are attending the convention, please give John some help.
- Revenue for ER was discussed. Carl suggested a cash raffle. There will be 25% of the take to first place, 15% to second place and 10% to third place. Jeff and John will send the committee (Carl and Wayne) links to purchase raffle tickets. Michele acquired a wind restrictor from Corvette Central for a C7-2014 thru 2017. It is worth approximately \$450.00. It is illuminated and is etched "Living the Dream" with an etched Corvette. She will have tickets available at Corvettes at Carlisle.
