REGIONAL MEMBERSHIP DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

George filled in for the vacationing George Fanucci. At the close of renewals, we had 2,243 paid members. This is the best we have ever renewed. We also have a new club that joined the East Region (ER). It's the All-American Corvette Club in New Jersey (AACCINJ) (ER-484) with 45 members. Their governor is Felipe Vazquez. We welcome them to the ER. We lost one club, Tri-State in Philadelphia. George challenged every club to bring in 10 new members this year. And if we can renew those 10 new members it would put the ER over 2,500 members, which keeps us ahead of the California West Region. We are still number one in the country.

Our NCCC packets are in the mail. Rose Smith is in charge of getting those to you. Blue Bars are also being mailed. Also the standing rules were mailed to the governors. NCCC rulebooks are available for \$10.00. It's important that new members know that in

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Rulebook Changes - The following recommendations will be presented for the rulebook.

1. No passenger in car at any speed events.
2. FTD points
3. Tires - per axle -- per class
4. Validation of drag records
5. Scatter shields for C5's and allow metric studs in Group 3
6. Callaway exclusions
7. Requirements for convertibles in high speed events -- roll-bar vs. hard top
8. Bring up the 150-mile rule. Maybe change it to 100 miles.

A lengthy discussion followed the above items. You had to be there to hear the comments.

Brian is hoping all the governors have tried out the newest results program sheet on the East Region Web Page. He is willing to help anyone who may be having problems working with this page. It saves a tremendous amount of his time getting the results to National by using this form. Please use the instructions he has included in your competition booklet. He wants this program result sheet to be used by the governors for each event next year. Remember -- you have 15 days to get your results to him. These results can be sent via email to him within days of your event. Please contact him if you need help. George F. and Brian have spent an enormous amount of time putting this program together. Please practice using the form over the next few months.
